## McPherson ERI Visiting Scholar Opportunity 2019

The McPherson Eye Research Institute has allocated funds to support one Visiting Scholar invited to the UW-Madison campus by a McPherson ERI member. (McPherson ERI members from other institutions can also be invited to UW-Madison as Visiting Scholars.) Funds will be available to support the costs of travel and lodging (up to \$2000).

The purpose of this opportunity is to facilitate lasting collaborations and/or training in support of broadly vision-related research including bioengineering, technology development, imaging, data visualization, cognitive psychology and/or neuroscience, ophthalmology, and general biology of the eye.\* [\*Please call Gail Stirr, 265-4023, for clarification on vision-related research, if in doubt.]

The proposed scholar's visit should be planned for a minimum of three full days (four nights) and up to a week. Funding maximum is \$2000 from the McPherson ERI. Junior faculty applicants are particularly encouraged to apply, but faculty at all levels are welcome to apply.

**Submit applications by February 1st, 2019 to Gail Stirr** (<a href="mailto:gmstirr@wisc.edu">gmstirr@wisc.edu</a>). Review by the Education Committee will be completed in February, with the selected McPherson ERI-member host to be notified immediately. The host can then communicate with the Visiting Scholar to schedule his/her time at UW-Madison between March 1, 2019 and December 20, 2019.

## **Application components**

- Specifically address the following points (one-page limit, using Arial font 11pt min):
- A. McPherson ERI member name, department, and current appointment
- B. Visitor information: name, department, institution
- C. Outline goals of the visit to the PI's research group; must be vision-related
- D. Breadth of opportunity for impact of the proposed visit (e.g., specificity of need in the lab, benefit to lab members; potential connection with other McPherson ERI members, labs and departments; potential for new grants)
- E. Propose and describe at least one event that other McPherson ERI members could attend during the visit, such as a lecture, workshop, roundtable, mini-symposium, etc. This event would be planned by the hosting McPherson ERI member.
- Include Visitor's short CV/biosketch (max 5 pages)
- *Include an email message or letter from invited visitor* indicating his/her commitment to come to UW-Madison within the identified timeframe [3/1/19 12/20/19] if your proposal is selected. Confirmation of the invited visitor's understanding that he/she has committed to a visit is essential.
